Report from the Annual Meeting of the Lake Townsend Yacht Club!

The Club's Annual meeting, held at Café Pasta on November 17, attracted 40+ club members, at which the 2008 officers were elected and the Club calendar and budget approved.

Budget: The Lake Townsend Yacht Club is in a very good fiscal position. It will finish the current year with more than a \$4,000 operating surplus and approximately \$16,000 in the bank. The 2008 budget is based on similar revenues to those of 2007 but reflects increased spending in the areas of fleet maintenance, instructor recognition, socials and meetings, and publicity. The budget is considered to be an estimate and indication of future spending but actual expenditures will be approved by the club's board of directors as required.

Steve Raper will be the Rear Commodore chairing the Education Committee. David Young will be the Board Secretary and be responsible for publicity. Serving as Directors will Uwe Heine, Newsletter and Directory; Starling Gunn, Cruise Meister; David Duff, Junior Sailing; Kim Kirsch, Membership; Committee Chair; Fred Lupton, Property and Past Commodore, George Bageant, Nominating. Steve Raper will continue as the webmaster

The Board is seeking a Board member to direct the Mayor's Cup and a Board member to manage the social schedule.
