Calling All Sailors!

While you're planning all the fun sailing things you'll do in 2017, don't forget to sign up on the scratch sheets for Race Committee and Sailing Class Instructor or Assistant.

On Volunteering:

This is a volunteer club. Everything that is done or decided upon is done by a volunteer. There are many emails that go out, asking for help in all kinds of things.

How can you help when you are so busy? Many of those who volunteer are overwhelmingly busy as well. What you can do is assist in little tasks. Don't have a dollar's worth of time? Give a nickel! Every task can be broken down into many little tasks. It doesn't have to be a long time commitment – little actions add up to big actions.

If we were all to get together and do the little tasks, we could get more done and have more fun. For example:

How can you help with the newsletter or publicity? Write an article, write a paragraph, write a sentence, share a post. Encourage others, and share the knowledge that you have. Share a lesson that you learned. Share why you bring extra clothes, why you put a knife in your life vest, why you wear a helmet.

On race day, help put marks on the boats, or anchors, or other equipment. Help raise and lower the flags on the pole. Help put the covers on the RC boats, or help other sailors set up or take down their boats. Bring plates and dinnerware from the shed at the socials, and help put them back again.

Share your enthusiasm and your love of the sport. Encourage or mentor a new sailor, or re-ignite the flame of a long ago sailor.

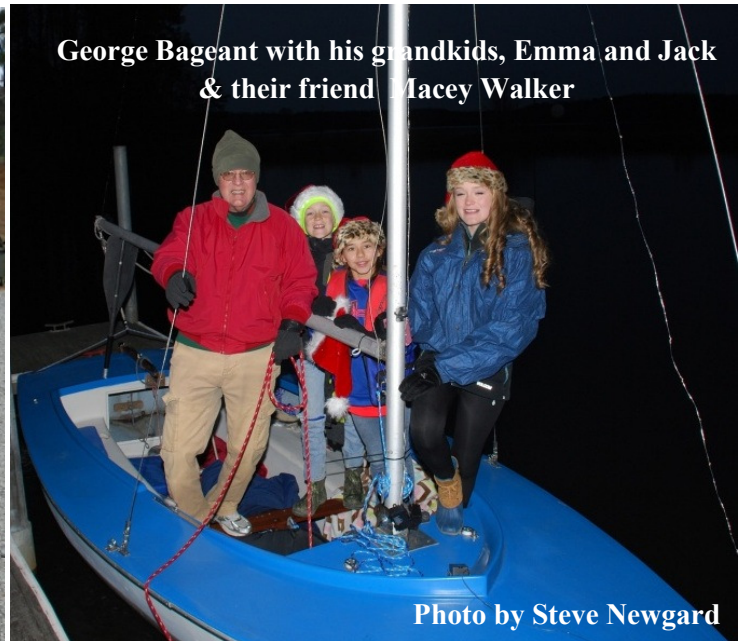
That person on the dock who looks interested: take him or her out for a sail. Introduce people to sailing, and share your skills with those just learning to sail.

Education, sailing classes, and continuing ed: Lend a hand, post a sailing flyer, talk to people who look interested. Volunteer to help teach a class, for a week or a couple of days. Bring your ideas, and lend a hand to help carry them out.

And finally: a great big THANKS to all the amazing volunteers.

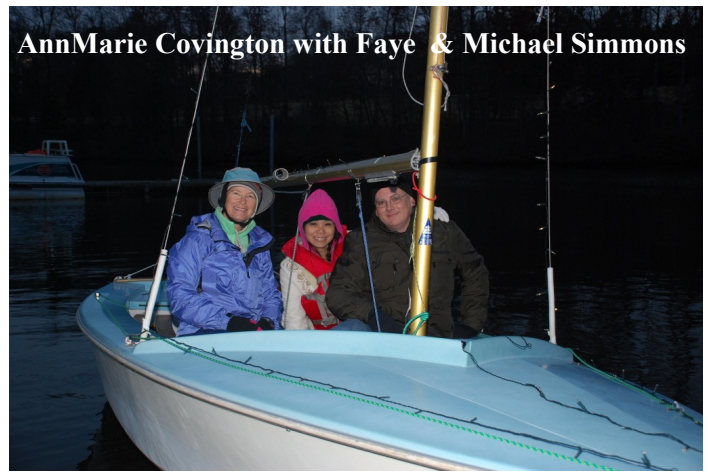

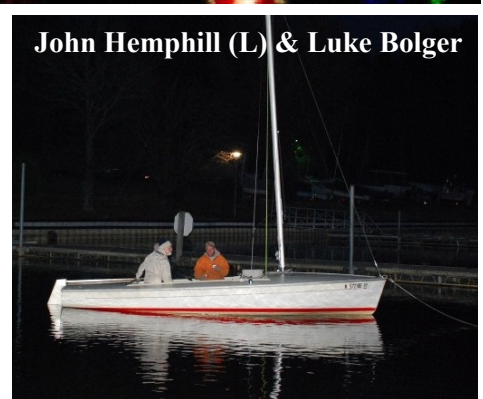

A note from Nancy Collins:

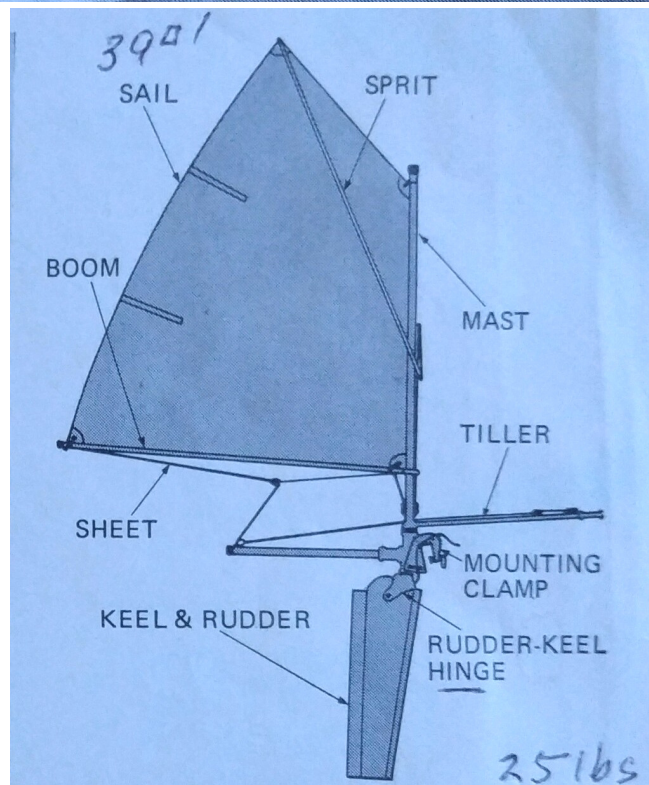
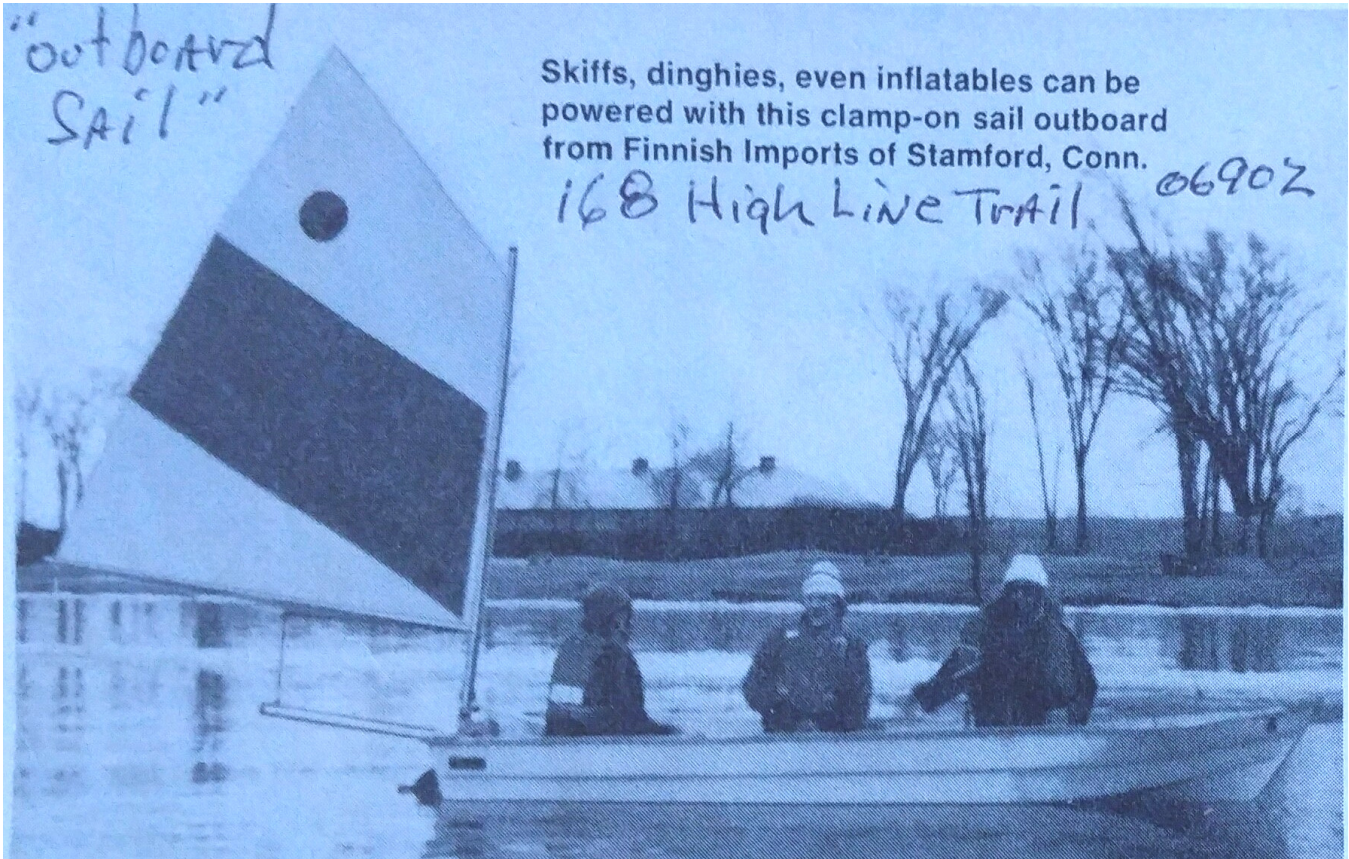
