OCTOBER SATURDAY RACING

It was a beautiful day at the lake with the fall colors beginning to arrive and a range of breezes.

In addition to the usual club announcements at the Competitors Meeting, members gave updates on the recent sailing events, VISA at Smith Mountain from the Scots & Wayfarers, and the Thistle Old Goat at Lake Norman along with an update on the JRDF (Junior Diabetes Foundation) Walk.

We moved people around a bit, sailors to RC, RC to sailing.

RC initially postponed at noon to allow the boats to arrive. Winds ranged from 4 to 16 knots. First two races had steady wind at 255. The wind shifted to 285 during the sequence of the 3rd race. RC postponed, and reset the course. The winds shifted at least 60 degrees back and forth during the 3rd race.

It was nice to have the “new” firehose” fenders at the dock and they served their purpose well as the sailboats arrived to the dock behind the fishing tournament. Eric demonstrated pivoting the pontoon boat and moving in sideways to the dock assisted by the wind, fitting between a Scat boat and a fishing boat.

Otto Afanador skippered two of the races and finished the 3 race first in the Scot Fleet. Trish McDermott & Scott Bogue sailed their first races in their gorgeous “new” Wayfarer. Kathy again crew with Phil Leonard on their Hobie 16; one of the benefits of having two kids married, and one off to college, we’ve got Kathy back!
