We are now accepting sponsors, volunteers and ideas. Sponsors can donate money and/or products. Items for the silent auction will be accepted also.



# April Racing at Lake Townsend

What an awesome weekend for sailing! Clear skies, temperatures in the 70s and the winds were “steady” from the Southwest at 10-15 mph, with occasional gusts to 20 mph. By steady I mean that the shifts were 15 degrees either side of 235! But that pattern held both days.

Saturday was the first day of racing for the Lake Townsend Yacht Club Summer Series. Someone will have to explain how the names of the weekends came about, but this one was named “Miss Piggy.” Seventeen boats came out to the starting line, including three from CSC. The courses were “WD” with an offset weather mark and gate marks to leeward. The Start/Finish line was set downwind of the gate marks. This made for fantastic spectating from the Signal boat. There were 10 Flying Scots on the line. The racing was tight with only 9 points separating the top 7 boats. At the end of the day it was Ray Merrill (sailing as a guest from CSC) on in first with 31 points, followed closely by John Hemphill with 29, Uwe Heine with 25



and Tom Bews with 25 points. Seven boats sailed in the open fleet with the Heffernans exhibiting their usual fast speed around the course. John F. from CSC also did well in his Laser, taking first in the second and third races.

There was some excitement in the third race when Starling misjudged his port tack crossing of Wendell. OOPS! The crash was heard around the lake. The damage to Wendell’s new boat was significant. I hope he is successful in getting it repaired soon. I have to say however that I am proud to be affiliated with LTYC. In an impressive display of sportsmanship, Wendell and Alex crewed for Starling on Sunday in the Inter-Club Regatta.
