

Flying Scot — Launch Checklist (Front)

From mast-up storage to floating at dock. Print double-sided (flip on short edge) for front/back cards.

1. Prepare parked boat for tow and launch

Check	Step	Description
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hitch trailer	Coupler latched, pin in, safety chains on, jack up
<input type="checkbox"/>	Remove cover	Take off and stow off ground to avoid ants
<input type="checkbox"/>	Inspect rig	Mast, shrouds, forestay, spreaders, cotter pins/tape
<input type="checkbox"/>	Halyards clear	Not wrapped around mast; run fair
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sails secured	Flaked on boom/forestay with ties
<input type="checkbox"/>	Main setup	Slugs in track, tack at gooseneck, clew to outhaul
<input type="checkbox"/>	Jib setup	Hanks/furling secure; sheets led outside shrouds
<input type="checkbox"/>	Mainsheet	Attached to traveler/bridle and boom
<input type="checkbox"/>	Check spinnaker sheets	Spinnaker sheets installed properly and connected to spinnaker
<input type="checkbox"/>	Check spinnaker halyard	Spinnaker halyard installed properly and connected to head of spinnaker
<input type="checkbox"/>	Vang attached	Connected, slack for now
<input type="checkbox"/>	Centerboard up	Uphaul secured; check for crank handle on board
<input type="checkbox"/>	Install drain plug	Tighten now to avoid misses
<input type="checkbox"/>	Load safety gear	Dock lines, fenders, PFDs, paddle, anchor, throwable, first aid
<input type="checkbox"/>	Secure loose gear	Stow in cockpit or vehicle
<input type="checkbox"/>	Walk-around	Final hazard and gear check; remove chocks

2. Ramp & launch

Check	Step	Description
<input type="checkbox"/>	Park clear	Stay out of ramp traffic
<input type="checkbox"/>	Dock lines & fenders	Attach lines fore/aft; fenders dock side
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rudder up, halyards ready	Rudder locked up; halyards free; tiller stored on center (bungee or free sheet)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Centerboard secured	Still up
<input type="checkbox"/>	Wind check	Plan docking side and hoist angle
<input type="checkbox"/>	Bow secured	Painter attached
<input type="checkbox"/>	Apron pause	Last step on ramp: remove winch strap & safety chain, retain painter
<input type="checkbox"/>	Back in until boat floats away	Trailer deep enough; crew retains control using painter
<input type="checkbox"/>	Guide off	Use bow & stern lines
<input type="checkbox"/>	Secure to dock	Fore and aft using cleat hitch

Departure tip: leave under main alone; hoist jib when clear and stable.

3. Final rigging afloat

Check	Step	Description
<input type="checkbox"/>	Lower rudder blade	Secure downhaul
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hoist main	Into wind; halyard, cunningham, outhaul set
<input type="checkbox"/>	Remove mast supports	If used for storage
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hoist jib	Set halyard tension for conditions
<input type="checkbox"/>	Lower Centerboard	Lower slowly, make sure the line is free.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Stow trailer gear	Back in the vehicle
<input type="checkbox"/>	Safety check	Centerboard ready; sheets free; crew briefed

Flying Scot — Recovery & Storage Checklist (Back)

From sailing to mast-up storage, covered.

1. Approach & docking

Check	Step	Description
<input type="checkbox"/>	Drop/furl jib early	Reduce power; improve visibility
<input type="checkbox"/>	Check painter	Tie painter to front cleat if needed.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ease main to slow	Control speed, Button hook into wind and use sail as an air brake to control speed
<input type="checkbox"/>	Luff alongside	Stop cleanly into wind
<input type="checkbox"/>	Secure bow, then stern	Crew steps ashore with bow line, let boom out. Crew ties off using cleat hitch

2. De-rig at dock

Check	Step	Description
<input type="checkbox"/>	Drop & flake main	Secure to boom, support boom using boom crutch
<input type="checkbox"/>	Flake/furl jib	Tidy on forestay or furl
<input type="checkbox"/>	Coil & secure lines	Sheets and halyards
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rudder up & secure	Protect the blade
<input type="checkbox"/>	Raise Centerboard	Use line to raise centerboard until tight, secure line in cleat.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fenders on	If not already hung

3. Load onto trailer

Check	Step	Description
<input type="checkbox"/>	Retrieve trailer	Back down ramp straight
<input type="checkbox"/>	Release dock lines	Keep bow line in hand
<input type="checkbox"/>	Guide onto trailer	Walk with bow line; float on straight
<input type="checkbox"/>	Winch to 8-12 inches slack	Leave enough slack in the winch line to allow the boat to rotate from partial float to level.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Winch to bow stop	Once boat trailer is up on the level, crack winch to bow stop.Attach safety chain
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pull clear of water	Stop on ramp apron
<input type="checkbox"/>	Remove drain plug	Let water out before towing
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rinse boat & trailer	If needed, and no one is waiting

4. Return to mast-up storage

Check	Step	Description
<input type="checkbox"/>	Tow to storage	Drive carefully
<input type="checkbox"/>	Chock trailer wheels	Prevent movement
<input type="checkbox"/>	verify plug removed	Remove drain plug, stow in bow of trailer/boat up to ensure free drainage
<input type="checkbox"/>	Remove loose gear	Vehicle or locker
<input type="checkbox"/>	Inspect rigging	Note wear/damage
<input type="checkbox"/>	Cover sails	Boom/mainsail cover; jib cover if used
<input type="checkbox"/>	Install full boat cover	Secure straps/ties
<input type="checkbox"/>	Final walk-around	Cover tight; nothing loose
<input type="checkbox"/>	Unhitch trailer	Last step only
